

Program Highlights

Back Office Nonprofit Empowerment Support

Thanks to a grant from the Silicon Valley Community Foundation, the Lodi Community Foundation launched the Back Office Nonprofit Empowerment Support (BONES) initiative to provide local nonprofit leaders with access to expert consulting in core areas of organizational health. Lodi House, LOEL Senior Center, and One-Eighty Programs were the first organizations to receive support through BONES.

209Gives Matching Grants

LCF awarded **\$12,775** in total matching grants to 15 local nonprofit organizations in support of 209Gives—an annual online giving day, designed to strengthen local nonprofits and inspire community-wide philanthropy.

Food Now Fund

Through a partnership between the Lodi Community Foundation and the San Joaquin Community Foundation, the Food Now Fund was launched to help local food banks meet increased demand stemming from uncertainty around SNAP (CalFresh) benefits. Thanks to generous individual donors and matching grant contributions, the fund has already provided over **\$70,000** in total support to Bread of Life, Emergency Food Bank Stockton, Grace & Mercy Charitable Foundation, Lodi Salvation Army, and Second Harvest.
